### Flexible **Start** and **Finish** Times from Monday 14<sup>th</sup> September

- **Breakfast Club** - drop off between 8.00 am and 8.15 am at your usual entrance
- **Flexible start** - 8.25 am - 9.00 am daily
- **Flexible finish time** - (2.30 finishers) between 2.25 pm and 2.45 pm
- **Flexible finish time** - (3.30 finishers) between 3.25 pm and 3.40 pm

*In order to reduce the number of adults waiting at the front of the school, please try not to arrive at the school gate before the earliest finish time. Thank you for your support with this.*

### Entry to School - New One Way System

**Please use the double gates to ENTER school** (When there is no member of staff at the gate, please ensure that you close it behind you and secure the bolt)

**Please use the single gate to EXIT the school grounds** (When there is no member of staff at the exit gate, please ensure that you secure the bolt and also place the metal hook over the top of the gate)

## School Fund

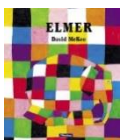


A huge thank you to everyone that has already contributed to our school fund.
