Young Entrepreneurs

Over the last few years our nursery has taken part in 'Young Entrepreneurs'. This is a Stockport initiative that encourages children of all ages to gain some experience of setting up a business. This year is no exception and the children have begun decorating various wooden items ready to sell. Items we have made will be on sale daily during the week beginning 2nd July and at the following times:

11.15 - for morning children

2.30 - for normal finish time

3.30 - for after school club children

The week following the sale of our items, a small group of us will go to the town hall to take part in a Dragon's Den style event. Some of our items will also be sold there. The children are going to be making posters with all the information on, including items for sale and cost. These should be displayed around nursery very shortly.

Tapestry
