Dear Parents/Carers

Building work update!

You will be thrilled to hear that our building work is now officially complete and we have started using the new outdoor space. The gardener has been very busy preparing this space after the building work was finished and the children now have a fantastic new outdoor learning environment. We will keep you up to date with our plans for the large area at the side of the new build. Some of the children would like a mini Crocky trail!

We have also been making some changes to our indoor area. We have added some bright new rugs and beanbags for the children to sit on. We have begun to develop a new reading area in the nursery and will be ordering some new furniture to enhance the space.

Tapestry and assessments

It has been fantastic to see so many contributions on Tapestry and they are really supporting our assessments of the children. Apologies if they sometimes take a long time before they are added to the journal, however, all assessments have to be approved by a senior member of staff. We have also received lots of WOW! moments on our special sheets and these will be added to your child's learning journey.

Staffing

We are pleased to let you know that we have appointed a new teacher who will be joining us at the beginning of next half term. Miss Farndell will become responsible for Mrs Harrison's green group with Miss Zubir supporting her. This will ensure that the children continue to have an adult with whom they are very familiar. Miss Farndell will also be supporting the children in silver group that are accessing the 30 hour provision.

Open Day

School will be closed on Wednesday 3^{rd} January when we will be hosting our annual Open Day for prospective parents. School reopens following the Christmas break on the 4^{th} January.

Christmas Concert

Wednesday, 6^{th} December- venue St Winifred's church hall. 10.30 am and 1.30 pm. In the first instance we will be offering 2 tickets per family at a cost of £1 per ticket. We are limited to the number of tickets we offer as the church hall has a maximum capacity to adhere to. I am sure you will understand we need to keep audience numbers at a safe level.

We would like to make all parents aware that if we have any parents who do not agree to this we are unable to let anyone take photographs or videos. There are a number of reasons why a parent/carer may not wish for their child to be filmed and we would ask that everyone respects their wishes. As we will be walking the children to and from the church hall for the concert we do require consent from parents/carers. A little nearer the time group leaders will have a sheet for you to sign if you are happy for us to do this.

- Please remember to always place the large metal hook over the main gate on entering and leaving (this is most important during drop off and pick up times).
 We recognise that this takes time but are sure you will appreciate how necessary it is.
