

Our Core Books for Developing Language









We have developed a sequenced language programme that progresses children's language skills through developing a love of story. Alongside other programmes such as Helicopter Stories and Tales Toolkit, children immerse themselves in the world of story through core books each chosen for their repeated language.

We start with very short stories and progress to stories with more complex language with the aim to develop understanding, oral language, listening and attention skills and imaginative skills with the final aim being for children to use all of their new language and knowledge to be able to tell their own stories.
