

## Helping you further

To use our service, you need to obtain a voucher or a voucher code from a referral agency.

We work in partnership with other agencies to ensure that people get the help that they need and do not become reliant on the foodbank. You may already be receiving help from a social worker, health visitor, support worker or similar. If you are, then speak to them about accessing the foodbank and other support.

## Getting a foodbank voucher or code

Lots of organisations can give out foodbank vouchers/voucher codes:

**Stockport Homes** If you rent your property from Stockport Homes, please call them for foodbank vouchers and financial help - 0161 217 6016 (option 3 then option 4).
