School fund Voluntary Contributions

Thank you so much to everyone who has already contributed to our school fund. The last date to contribute for this academic year is Monday, 8th July, as we have to prepare our accounts to be audited.

As you know, we ask if parents would be willing to contribute £2.75 per week towards our school fund. This voluntary contribution can be paid by cash/cheque/BACS or via a card payment through Parentmail. Kindly note from September, if your child is remaining at Freshfield, we will be requesting a slight increase to school fund donations to£3 per week.

How to use payments on IRIS Parentmail:

- Click 'Payments'
- Click 'Shop' at the bottom of the screen

We use school fund money to pay for fruit in the nursery together with a cake and a present to give to each child on their birthday. If any money is left over, we save this up to buy valuable resources for the nursery. You may be interested to learn, we do not receive free fruit in early years' settings like the primary schools do.
