School Fund

As you know, we ask if parents would be willing to contribute £3.00 per week towards our school fund. This voluntary contribution can be paid by cash/cheque/BACS or via a card payment through Parentmail. For Oct half term to Christmas this amount is £24.

We use school fund money to pay for fruit for the children, together with a cake and a present to give to each child on their birthday. If any money is left over, we save this up to buy valuable resources for the nursery. As you may know, we do not receive free fruit in early years' settings like a primary school does.
